AKTA PENCEGAHAN DAN PENGAWALAN PENYAKIT BERJANGKIT 1988

PERINTAH PENCEGAHAN DAN PENGAWALAN PENYAKIT BERJANGKIT
(PENGECUALIAN) 2021

PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 29 Akta Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit 1988 [*Akta 342*], Menteri membuat perintah yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Perintah ini bolehlah dinamakan **Perintah Pencegahan dan Pengawalan Penyakit Berjangkit (Pengecualian) 2021**.

(2) Perintah ini berkuat kuasa bagi tempoh mulai 9 Februari 2021 hingga 1 Ogos 2021.

Pengecualian

2. Tertakluk kepada perenggan 3, Menteri mengecualikan Jemaah Menteri yang kembali dari mana-mana lawatan rasmi luar negara daripada pemakaian seksyen 15 Akta.

Syarat pengecualian

3. Jemaah Menteri yang kembali dari mana-mana lawatan rasmi luar negara hendaklah menjalani pemerhatian selama tiga hari atau menjalani pengawasan sehingga boleh dilepaskan tanpa membahayakan orang ramai.

PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT 1988

PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES
(EXEMPTION) ORDER 2021

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988 [Act 342], the Minister makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Exemption) Order 2021**.

(2) This Order has effect for the period from 9 February 2021 to 1 August 2021.

Exemption

2. Subject to paragraph 3, the Minister exempts the Cabinet of Ministers who returns from any overseas official visit from the application of section 15 of the Act.

Condition of exemption

3. The Cabinet of Ministers who returns from any overseas official visit shall undergo observation for three days or undergo surveillance until be discharged without danger to the public.
