FEES ACT 1951

FEES (PASSPORTS AND VISAS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Fees Act 1951 [*Act 209*], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **Fees (Passports and Visas) (Amendment) Order 2019**.

(2) This Order comes into operation on 2 January 2019.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. The Fees (Passports and Visas) Order 1967 [*P.U. 189/1967*] is amended in paragraph 2 by inserting after subitem I(*ca*) the following subitem:
