FEES ACT 1951

FEES (PASSPORTS AND VISAS) (REMISSION OF FEES) (NO. 2) ORDER 2017

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Fees Act 1951 [*Act 209*], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **Fees (Passports and Visas) (Remission of Fees) (No. 2) Order 2017**.

(2) This Order comes into operation on 28 August 2017.

Remission of fees

2. The fee for Malaysia Passport payable under item 2.I(c) of the Fees (Passports and Visas) Order 1967 [*P.U. 189/1967*] is remitted one hundred percent for any officer and staff of the Immigration Department of Malaysia.

Revocation

3. The Fees (Passports and Visas) (Remission of Fees) Order 2011 [*P.U. (A) 236/2011*] is revoked.
