AKTA PEGAWAI-PEGAWAI DIPLOMAT DAN KONSUL (SUMPAH DAN FI) 1959

PERATURAN-PERATURAN PEGAWAI-PEGAWAI DIPLOMAT DAN KONSUL
(SUMPAH DAN FI) (PEREMITAN FI) 2017

PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh subseksyen 4(2) Akta Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Sumpah dan Fi) 1959 [*Akta 348*], Yang di-Pertuan Agong membuat peraturan-peraturan yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Peraturan-peraturan ini bolehlah dinamakan **Peraturan-Peraturan Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Sumpah dan Fi) (Peremitan Fi) 2017**.

(2) Peraturan-Peraturan ini berkuat kuasa bagi tempoh dari 22 Ogos 2017 hingga 31 Julai 2018.

Peremitan fi

2. (1) Fi bagi visa kemasukan berulang kali yang kena dibayar di bawah perenggan B Jadual kepada Perintah Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Fi) (No. 3) 1962 [*F.L.N. 239/1962*] bagi butiran India diremitkan satu ratus peratus.

(2) Peremitan fi di bawah subperenggan (1) hanya terpakai bagi warganegara India yang datang ke Malaysia bagi maksud lawatan sosial, tertakluk kepada syarat yang berikut:

- (a) permohonan bagi visa kemasukan berulang kali dibuat melalui Sistem Elektronik Visa;
- (b) visa kemasukan berulang kali adalah sah bagi tempoh tiga bulan dari tarikh kelulusan visa;
- (c) tempoh tinggal di Malaysia terhad kepada lima belas hari sahaja bagi setiap kemasukan dan tidak boleh dilanjutkan; dan

(d) masuk dan keluar dari Malaysia hanya melalui pos kawalan imigresen, tempat mendarat yang dibenarkan, lapangan terbang yang dibenarkan atau pintu masuk yang dibenarkan sebagaimana yang diwartakan di bawah subseksyen 5(1) Akta Imigresen 1959/63 [*Akta 155*].

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (OATHS AND FEES) ACT 1959

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (OATHS AND FEES) (REMISSION OF FEES)
REGULATIONS 2017

IN exercise of the powers conferred by subsection 4(2) of the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Oaths and Fees) Act 1959 [Act 348], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Oaths and Fees) (Remission of Fees) Regulations 2017**.

(2) These Regulations have effect for the period from 22 August 2017 to 31 July 2018.

Remission of fees

2. (1) The fee for multiple entry visa payable under paragraph B of the Schedule to the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Fees) (No. 3) Order 1962 [F.L.N. 239/1962] for the item India is remitted one hundred percent.

(2) The remission of fee under subparagraph (1) shall only apply to a citizen of India who comes to Malaysia for the purpose of social visit, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) an application for the multiple entry visa is made through Electronic Visa System;
- (b) the multiple entry visa is valid for the period of three months from the date of the approval of the visa;
- (c) the period of stay in Malaysia is limited to fifteen days only for each entry and shall not be extended; and

- (d) enter into and exit from Malaysia only through the immigration control posts, authorized landing places, authorized airports or authorized points of entry as gazetted under subsection 5(1) of the Immigration Act 1959/63 [*Act 155*].
