PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh subseksyen 4(2) Akta Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Sumpah dan Fi) 1959 [*Akta 348*], Yang di-Pertuan Agong membuat peraturan-peraturan yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Peraturan-peraturan ini bolehlah dinamakan **Peraturan-Peraturan Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Sumpah dan Fi) (Peremitan Fi) 2015**.

(2) Peraturan-Peraturan ini mula berkuat kuasa pada 15 Januari 2015.

Peremitan fi

2. Fi bagi Pasport Malaysia yang kena dibayar di bawah Perintah Pegawai-Pegawai Diplomat dan Konsul (Fi) (No. 3) 1962 [*F.L.N. 239/1962*] diremitkan—

(a) satu ratus peratus berkenaan dengan orang kurang upaya yang didaftarkan di bawah seksyen 24 Akta Orang Kurang Upaya 2008 [*Akta 685*] dan mempunyai Kad OKU yang dikeluarkan di bawah seksyen 25 Akta 685; dan

(b) lima puluh peratus berkenaan dengan—

- (i) orang yang berumur 60 tahun dan ke atas; dan
- (ii) jemaah haji.

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (OATHS AND FEES) ACT 1959

DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR OFFICERS (OATHS AND FEES) (REMISSION OF FEES)
REGULATIONS 2015

IN exercise of the powers conferred by subsection 4(2) of the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Oaths and Fees) Act 1959 [Act 348], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Oaths and Fees) (Remission of Fees) Regulations 2015**.

(2) These Regulations come into operation on 15 January 2015.

Remission of fees

2. The fees for Malaysia Passport payable under the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Fees) (No. 3) Order 1962 [F.L.N. 239/1962] is remitted—

(a) one hundred percent in respect of persons with disabilities registered under section 24 of the Person With Disabilities Act 2008 [Act 685] and having Kad OKU issued under section 25 of Act 685; and

(b) fifty percent in respect of—

(i) persons of the age of 60 years and above; and

(ii) hajj pilgrims.
