## FEES ACT 1951

## FEES (PASSPORTS AND VISAS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Fees Act 1951 [*Act 209*], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **Fees (Passports and Visas) (Amendment) Order 2012**.

(2) This Order comes into operation on 1 January 2013.

**Amendment of paragraph 2**

2. The Fees (Passports and Visas) Order 1967 [*P.U. 189/1967*] is amended in paragraph 2—

(a) by substituting for subitem I(c) the following subitem:

(c) by inserting after subitem I(ca) the following subitem:

“(cb) Malaysia Passport (Valid for 2 years)	RM100.00	— ;” and

(d) by deleting subitem I(d).
