KAEDAH-KAEDAH KENDERAAN MOTOR (PENDAFTARAN DAN PELESENAN)
(PINDAAN) (NO. 2) 2012

PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 66 Akta Pengangkutan Jalan 1987 [*Akta 333*], Menteri membuat kaedah-kaedah yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Kaedah-kaedah ini bolehlah dinamakan **Kaedah-Kaedah Kenderaan Motor (Pendaftaran dan Pelesenan) (Pindaan) (No. 2) 2012**.

(2) Kaedah-Kaedah ini mula berkuat kuasa pada 6 April 2012.

Kaedah baru 7A dan 7B

2. Kaedah-Kaedah Kenderaan Motor (Pendaftaran dan Pelesenan) 1959 [*L.N. 173/1959*], yang disebut “Kaedah-Kaedah ibu” dalam Kaedah-Kaedah ini, dipinda dengan memasukkan selepas kaedah 7 kaedah-kaedah yang berikut:

“Re-assignment of registration number for motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia

7A. (1) A registered owner of a motor vehicle may make an application to the Director for the re-assignment of the registration number of a motor vehicle, which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia, as the case may be, to a motor vehicle which has not been previously registered.

(2) The application for the re-assignment of the registration number referred to in subrule (1) shall be made in form JPJ K1A in the First Schedule.

(3) The Director, upon allowing the application made in subrule (2), may—

- (a) re-assign the registration number to a motor vehicle which has not been previously registered;
- (b) withdraw the registration number of the motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia; or
- (c) assign a new registration number to a motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia.

ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 1987

MOTOR VEHICLES (REGISTRATION AND LICENSING) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2)
RULES 2012

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the Road Transport Act 1987 [Act 333], the Minister makes the following rules:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be cited as the **Motor Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules 2012**.

(2) These Rules come into operation on 6 April 2012.

New rules 7A and 7B

2. The Motor Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Rules 1959 [*L.N. 173/1959*], which are referred to as the “principal Rules” in these Rules, are amended by inserting after rule 7 the following rules:

“Re-assignment of registration number for motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia

7A. (1) A registered owner of a motor vehicle may make an application to the Director for the re-assignment of the registration number of a motor vehicle, which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia, as the case may be, to a motor vehicle which has not been previously registered.

(2) The application for the re-assignment of the registration number referred to in subrule (1) shall be made in form JPJ K1A in the First Schedule.

(3) The Director, upon allowing the application made in subrule (2), may—

- (a) re-assign the registration number to a motor vehicle which has not been previously registered;
- (b) withdraw the registration number of the motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia; or
- (c) assign a new registration number to a motor vehicle which has been reported to be lost, stolen, broken up, destroyed or sent permanently out of Malaysia.

Fee for 7B. The fee to be paid for the purpose of rule 7A shall be as re-assignment of set out in item 10 of the Fourth Schedule.”. registration number
