JUDGES' REMUNERATION ACT 1971

JUDGES' REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES) REGULATIONS 1993

Act 45.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Judges' Remuneration Act 1971, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, after consultation with the Lord President, makes the following regulations:

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Judges' Remuneration (Amendment of Schedules) Regulations 1993**.

2. (1) The Judges' Remuneration Act 1971, which in these Regulations is referred to as the "Act", is amended by substituting for the First Schedule the following:

(2) Subregulation (1) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 1989.

3. The First Schedule to the Act as substituted in regulation 2 is amended by substituting therefor the following:

(a) by substituting for paragraph 1 the following:

“1. ACCOMMODATION:

(1) <i>Judges</i>	(2) <i>Effective Date</i>
1. Lord President and Chief Justices—	
(i) free fully furnished institutional quarters, or in lieu thereof a house rent subsidy of \$3150.00 per month in the case of the Lord President and \$2500.00 per month in the case of a Chief Justice; and	1-1-1992
(ii) one butler, two gardeners and one caretaker and a provision of \$1500.00 per annum for house and garden upkeep	1-7-1980
2. Judges of the Supreme Court and the High Courts—	
(i) free fully furnished institutional quarters which (including the compound) shall be maintained free of charge, or in lieu thereof a house rent subsidy of \$2250.00 per month; and	1-1-1992
(ii) one butler and one caretaker and a provision of \$1500.00 per annum for house and garden upkeep	1-7-1980

The privilege and allowance in this paragraph shall be accorded or paid notwithstanding that the Judge has been granted a loan under the housing loans scheme referred to in paragraph 14.

In this paragraph, “free fully furnished institutional quarters” means housing accommodation provided free of rent by the Government and furnished in accordance with the guidelines of the Government for the furnishing of such accommodation.”;

(b) by substituting for paragraph 2 the following:

"2. ENTERTAINMENT ALLOWANCE:

(1) <i>Judges</i>	(2) <i>Amount</i>	(3) <i>Effective Date</i>
1. Lord President	\$3500.00 per month	1-1-1992
2. Chief Justice Malaya	\$3150.00 per month	1-1-1992
3. Chief Justice Borneo	\$3150.00 per month	1-1-1992

5. Judges of the High Courts in Malaya and Borneo	\$2800.00 per month	1-1-1992

(c) by inserting, immediately after paragraph 16, the following new paragraph 17:

"17. SPECIAL JUDICIAL ALLOWANCE:

1. Lord President	\$4000.00 per month	1-1-1992
2. Chief Justice Malaya	\$3000.00 per month	1-1-1992
3. Chief Justice Borneo	\$3000.00 per month	1-1-1992
4. Judges of the Supreme Court	\$2500.00 per month	1-1-1992
5. Judges of the High Courts in Malaya and Borneo	\$2400.00 per month	1-1-1992

Commencement. 5. Regulations 3 and 4 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 1992.
