4. MEDICAL FACILITIES:

Free outpatient treatment for Chairmen, Deputy Chairmen, members, their spouses and children but in case of hospitalisation daily ward charges are payable according to rates chargeable for Division I officers except where hospitalisation is as a result of injuries sustained in the course of duty. Where the Chairman, Deputy Chairman or member is a pensioner he may opt for the medical facilities available to pensioners.

“Child” means any dependant child below 21 years of age of the Chairman, Deputy Chairman or member, or any dependant child pursuing a first degree in an institution of higher learning and includes a child who is mentally retarded or physically handicapped in which case the age limit shall not apply. It shall also include a stepchild or a child adopted under any recognised law or custom.

5. LEAVE:

Thirty days vacation leave in respect of each completed year of service with the Commission shall be granted.

6. MONTHLY HOUSING ALLOWANCE:

Furnished Class "B" or "C" quarters shall be provided free of charge or if not living in quarters housing allowance at the following rates shall be payable—

7. GRATUITY:

- (a) on the expiry of the term of appointment of the member but where a member is appointed for more than one term he may opt either to be paid at the end of each term or until he has completed all the terms (in either case he is only entitled to exemption from income tax only once); or
- (b) to such of his dependants as may be determined by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong or if there are no dependants, to his personal representative, on his death while holding office.

8. ADVANCE TO PURCHASE MOTOR VEHICLES:

(eligibility once every 4 years and payable within the term of office of the member during which the advance is given subject to other terms and conditions as may be determined by the Treasury from time to time).

SERVICE COMMISSIONS (AMENDMENT OF SECOND SCHEDULE)
REGULATIONS 1981

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Service Commissions Ordinance 1957 the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations: 74/57.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the **Service Commissions (Amendment of Second Schedule) Regulations 1981** and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st July 1980. Citation and commencement.

2. The Second Schedule to the Service Commissions Ordinance 1957 is amended by substituting the following therefor: Amendment of Second Schedule. 74/57.

CUSTOMS DUTIES (EXEMPTION) (No. 2) (AMENDMENT) (No. 3)
ORDER 1981

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1) of the Customs Act 1967, the Minister makes the following Order: *Act 235.*

1. This Order may be cited as the **Customs Duties (Exemption) (No. 2) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1981** and shall come into force on the 9th April 1981. *Citation and commencement.*

2. Part I of the Schedule to the Customs Duties (Exemption) (No. 2) Order 1977 is amended by adding immediately after item 102, the new item as appearing in the Schedule. *Amendment of Part I of Schedule. P.U. (A) 423/77.*
