PERINTAH NEGERI SABAH (PEMERLUASAN DAN UBAH SUAIAN AKTA KEHADIRAN
WAJIB PESALAH-PESALAH 1954) 2012

PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 74 Akta Malaysia [Akta 26/1963], Yang di-Pertuan Agong membuat perintah yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Perintah ini bolehlah dinamakan **Perintah Negeri Sabah (Pemerluasan dan Ubah Suaian Akta Kehadiran Wajib Pesalah-Pesalah 1954) 2012**.

(2) Perintah ini mula berkuat kuasa pada 16 September 2012.

Pemerluasan dan ubah suaian Akta ke Negeri Sabah

2. (1) Akta Kehadiran Wajib Pesalah-Pesalah 1954 [Akta 461], yang disebut "Akta yang diperluas" dalam Perintah ini, diperluas ke Negeri Sabah.

(2) Dalam pemakaiannya bagi Negeri Sabah, Akta yang diperluas diubah suai mengikut cara yang dinyatakan dalam Jadual.

MALAYSIA ACT

STATE OF SABAH (EXTENSION AND MODIFICATION OF THE OFFENDERS
COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE ACT 1954) ORDER 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Malaysia Act [Act 26/1963], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **State of Sabah (Extension and Modification of the Offenders Compulsory Attendance Act 1954) Order 2012**.

(2) This Order comes into operation on 16 September 2012.

Extension and modification of the Act to the State of Sabah

2. (1) The Offenders Compulsory Attendance Act 1954 [Act 461], which is referred to as the "extended Act" in this Order, is extended to the State of Sabah.

(2) In its application to the State of Sabah, the extended Act is modified in the manner as set out in the Schedule.
