PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 13 Akta Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan 1957 [*Akta 393*], Yang di-Pertuan Agong membuat peraturan-peraturan yang berikut:

Nama dan permulaan kuat kuasa

1. (1) Peraturan-peraturan ini bolehlah dinamakan **Peraturan-Peraturan Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan (Pindaan Jadual) 2012**.

(2) Peraturan-Peraturan ini disifatkan telah mula berkuat kuasa pada 1 Ogos 2012.

Pindaan Jadual

2. Jadual kepada Akta dipinda—

(a) di bawah tajuk “SALARIES AND FIXED ALLOWANCES”—

(i) berkenaan dengan tajuk “PUBLIC SERVICES COMMISSION”, dengan menggantikan subperenggan 1, 2 dan 3 dengan subperenggan yang berikut:

- (ii) berkenaan dengan tajuk "JUDICIAL AND LEGAL SERVICE COMMISSION", dengan menggantikan angka "6,379.64" dengan angka "11,264.26";
- (iii) berkenaan dengan tajuk "POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION", dengan menggantikan angka "6,379.64" dengan angka "11,264.26"; dan
- (iv) berkenaan dengan tajuk "EDUCATION SERVICE COMMISSION", dengan menggantikan subperenggan 1, 2 dan 3 dengan subperenggan yang berikut:

	<i>Per month</i>
"1. Chairman: Salary	RM14,607.70
2. Deputy Chairman: Salary	RM12,201.84
3. Members: Fixed allowance	RM11,264.26";

(b) di bawah tajuk "ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES APPLICABLE TO ALL COMMISSIONS"—

"8. ADVANCE TO PURCHASE MOTOR VEHICLES:

(payable within the term of office of the member during which the advance is given on such terms and conditions as stipulated in the Treasury Circular or Circular Letter for Advance to Purchase Motor Vehicles for members of the public services or as may be determined by the Treasury from time to time)

Chairmen and Deputy Chairmen of all Service Commissions	RM70,000
Members of all Service Commissions	RM65,000";

- (ii) dengan menggantikan perenggan 9 dengan perenggan yang berikut:

“9. MEETING ALLOWANCE:

(a) The Chairman of Public Services Commission shall receive an allowance of RM500 per day or part thereof for attending a meeting or meetings of Judicial and Legal Service Commission or any Committee or Board thereof.

(b) (applicable only to *ex-officio* members and members appointed from among serving judges and other Commissions)

There shall be paid an allowance of RM300 per day or part thereof for attending a meeting or meeting of a Commission or any Committee or Board thereof or as may be determined by the Government from time to time.”; dan

- (iii) dengan memasukkan selepas perenggan 23 perenggan yang berikut:

“24. SICK LEAVE:

A member of a Commission is entitled to sick leave subject to the terms and conditions stipulated in Part III Chapter C General Orders 1974 and the Services Circular No. 2 of 2006 or any amendments thereto.”.

SERVICE COMMISSIONS ACT 1957

SERVICE COMMISSIONS (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE)
REGULATIONS 2012

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Service Commissions Act 1957 [Act 393], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Service Commissions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2012**.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 1 August 2012.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Act is amended—

(a) under the heading “SALARIES AND FIXED ALLOWANCES”—

(i) in respect of the heading “PUBLIC SERVICES COMMISSION”, by substituting for subparagraphs 1, 2 and 3 the following subparagraphs:

	<i>Per month</i>
“1. Chairman: Salary	RM14,607.70
2. Deputy Chairman: Salary	RM12,201.84
3. Members: Fixed allowance	RM11,264.26”;

- (ii) in respect of the heading "JUDICIAL AND LEGAL SERVICE COMMISSION", by substituting for the figure "6,379.64" the figure "11,264.26";
- (iii) in respect of the heading "POLICE SERVICE COMMISSION", by substituting for the figure "6,379.64" the figure "11,264.26"; and
- (iv) in respect of the heading "EDUCATION SERVICE COMMISSION", by substituting for subparagraphs 1, 2 and 3 the following subparagraphs:

	<i>Per month</i>
"1. Chairman: Salary	RM14,607.70
2. Deputy Chairman: Salary	RM12,201.84
3. Members: Fixed allowance	RM11,264.26";

(b) under the heading "ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES APPLICABLE TO ALL COMMISSIONS"—

- (i) by substituting for paragraph 8 the following paragraph:

"8. ADVANCE TO PURCHASE MOTOR VEHICLES:

(payable within the term of office of the member during which the advance is given on such terms and conditions as stipulated in the Treasury Circular or Circular Letter for Advance to Purchase Motor Vehicles for members of the public services or as may be determined by the Treasury from time to time)

Chairmen and Deputy Chairmen of all Service Commissions	RM70,000
Members of all other Service Commissions	RM65,000";

(ii) by substituting for paragraph 9 the following paragraph:

“9. MEETING ALLOWANCE:

(a) The Chairman of Public Services Commission shall receive an allowance of RM500 per day or part thereof for attending a meeting or meetings of Judicial and Legal Service Commission or any Committee or Board thereof.

(b) (applicable only to *ex-officio* members and members appointed from among serving judges and other Commissions)

There shall be paid an allowance of RM300 per day or part thereof for attending a meeting or meeting of a Commission or any Committee or Board thereof or as may be determined by the Government from time to time.”; and

(iii) by inserting after paragraph 23 the following paragraph:

“24. SICK LEAVE:

A member of a Commission is entitled to sick leave subject to the terms and conditions stipulated in Part III Chapter C General Orders 1974 and the Services Circular No. 2 of 2006 or any amendments thereto.”.
