MINISTERIAL FUNCTIONS ACT 1969

MINISTERS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Ministerial Functions Act 1969 [Act 2], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following order:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This order may be cited as the **Ministers of the Federal Government (Amendment) Order 2003**.

(d) Warm Clothing Allowance

When required to carry out official duty in countries of temperate climate, a member of a Service Commission is eligible to a Warm Clothing Allowance on such terms and conditions as stipulated in Treasury Circular No. 2 Of 1992 or as may be determined by the Treasury from time to time.

23. *EX-GRATIA* SCHEME FOR WORK INJURY:

A member of a Service Commission who involved in an accident or injured while on official duty is entitled to receive benefit on such terms and conditions as stipulated in Treasury Circular No. 7 Of 2001 or as may be determined by the Treasury from time to time.”.

SERVICE COMMISSIONS (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) REGULATIONS 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Service Commissions Act 1957 [Act 393], the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the **Service Commissions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2003**.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 2 October 2002.
