SERVICE COMMISSIONS ORDINANCE 1957

SERVICE COMMISSIONS (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE)
REGULATIONS 1991

74/57.

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Service Commissions Ordinance 1957, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement.

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the **Service Commissions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 1991** and shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates specified in subparagraphs (2) and (3).

(2) Paragraph 2 (a) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 1991.

(3) Paragraph 2 (b) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st March 1991.

Amendment of Schedule. P.U. (A) 180/82.

2. The Schedule to the Service Commissions Ordinance 1957 is amended—

(a) by substituting for the particulars appearing under the heading “SALARIES AND FIXED ALLOWANCES” with the following:
