AKTA SARAAN HAKIM, 1971

Akta 45. PADA menjalankan kuasa-kuasa yang diberi oleh seksyen 19 Akta Saraan Hakim, 1971, Yang di-Pertuan Agong, selepas berunding dengan Ketua Hakim Negara, dengan ini membuat peraturan-peraturan yang berikut:

Nama. 1. Peraturan-peraturan ini bolehlah dinamakan **Peraturan-peraturan Saraan Hakim (Pindaan) (No. 2), 1975.**

Pindaan bagi Jadual Kedua. Akta 45. 2. Jadual Kedua kepada Akta Saraan Hakim, 1971 adalah dengan ini dipinda—

- (a) dengan memasukkan selepas sahaja perenggan 2, perenggan-perenggan baru 2A dan 2B yang berikut—

“2A. ELAUN WILAYAH:

Suatu Elaun Wilayah bulanan atas kadar 15% daripada gaji bulanan hendaklah dibayar kepada Hakim Besar dan Hakim-hakim Mahkamah Tinggi di Borneo selagi mereka berkhidmat dalam Negeri-negeri Borneo.

(berkuatkuasa mulai dari 1-10-1971 tertakluk kepada pemilihan di bawah seksyen 16).

“2B. ELAUN KHAS:

Apa-apa elaun khas, sebagaimana yang difikirkan patut diberi oleh Kerajaan menurut budibicaranya atas asas *ad hoc*.

(berkuatkuasa mulai dari 1-1-1974 tertakluk kepada pemilihan di bawah seksyen 16);”

- (b) dengan menambah selepas sahaja perkataan “sa-bulan” dalam perenggan 4 perkataan-perkataan “dan \$5 samalam belanja penginapan semasa Hakim bertugas di luar pejabat”.

- (c) dengan memotong perenggan 5 dan menggantikannya dengan perenggan 5 baru yang berikut—

“5. HITUNGAN BATU:

Kadar hitungan batu bagi Hakim-hakim Mahkamah Persekutuan dan Mahkamah Tinggi hendaklah

hanya setengah daripada kadar-kadar yang kena dibayar kepada pegawai-pegawai perkhidmatan awam dalam gred yang setaraf untuk perjalanan atas tugas rasmi.

(berkuatkuasa mulai dari 1-6-1974 tertakluk kepada pemilihan di bawah seksyen 16).”.

JUDGES' REMUNERATION ACT, 1971

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Judges' Remuneration Act, 1971, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, after consultation with the Lord President, hereby makes the following regulations: Act 45.

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Judges' Remuneration (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1975.** Citation.

2. The Second Schedule to the Judges' Remuneration Act, 1971 is hereby amended— Amendment of Second Schedule. Act 45.

(a) by inserting immediately after paragraph 2, the following new paragraphs 2A and 2B—

“2A. REGIONAL ALLOWANCE:

A monthly Regional Allowance at the rate of 15% of monthly salary shall be paid to the Chief Justice and Judges of the High Court in Borneo for so long as they serve in the Borneo States.

(effective from 1-10-1971 subject to election under section 16).

2B. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE:

Such special allowance as the Government may in its discretion deem fit to grant on an *ad hoc* basis.

(effective from 1-1-1974 subject to election under section 16).”;

(b) by adding immediately after the word “month” in paragraph 4 the words “and \$5 per night for lodging expenses when the judge is on outstation duty”.

(c) by deleting paragraph 5 and substituting therefor the following new paragraph 5—

“5. MILEAGE:

Rates of mileage for Judges of the Federal Court and the High Courts only shall be at half of the rates payable to officers of the public services of equivalent grade for journeys on official duty.

(effective from 1-6-1974 subject to election under section 16).”.
