PUBLIC ORDER (PRESERVATION) ORDINANCE, 1958

DECLARATION OF RENEWAL UNDER SECTION 3 (3)

I, Tun Dr Ismail bin Dato' Haji Abdul Rahman, being of the opinion that public order in the State of Sarawak is still seriously threatened and considering it to be necessary to do so for the purpose of maintaining public order in such State of Sarawak do hereby declare that the Proclamation dated 6th February, 1971 and published as P.U. (A) 54 on 18th February, 1971, be renewed for a further period of one month.

MALAYSIA ACT

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Malaysia Act, 26/63, the Yang di-Pertuan Agong hereby makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the **Bankers' Books (Evidence) Ordinance (Extension) Order, 1971**, and shall come into force on the first day of May, 1971. Citation and commencement.
2. The Bankers' Books (Evidence) Ordinance, 1949, shall have effect with the modifications set out in the Schedule to this Order, and as so modified is hereby extended to Sabah and Sarawak. Modification and extension of F.M. 52/49.

3. The Bankers' Books Evidence Ordinance of Sabah and the Bankers' Books (Evidence) Ordinance of Sarawak are hereby repealed.

MODIFICATIONS TO BE MADE TO THE BANKERS' BOOKS (EVIDENCE)
ORDINANCE, 1949

<i>Section</i>	<i>Modification</i>
2, definition of "bank" and "banker"	Substitute the following: " 'bank' and 'banker' mean any company carrying on the business of banking in Malaysia incorporated by or under any written law in force in Malaysia and any company carrying on such business in Malaysia under a licence granted under any written law in force in Malaysia relating to banking, and also any Post Office Savings Bank established in Malaysia;".
2, definition of "Court"	Substitute the following: " 'Court' means the High Court and in connection with any proceedings before a Sessions Court or, in the States of Sabah and Sarawak, before the Court of a Magistrate of the First Class, includes such Court;".
