**EMERGENCY (ESSENTIAL POWERS) ORDINANCE**  
**No. 2, 1969**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 5 of the Emergency (Essential Powers) Ordinance No. 2, 1969, I, Tun Haji Abdul Razak bin Dato' Hussein, Director of Operations, hereby appoint Major-General Dato' Syed Mohammad bin Syed Ahmad Alsagoff, D.P.M.J., J.M.N., P.J.K., as a member of the Sarawak State Operations Committee with effect from the 24th day of November, 1969.

2. The appointment of Major-General Ungku Nazaruddin bin Ungku Mohammad as a member of the Sarawak State Operations Committee *vide* P.U. (A) 171 dated 27th day of May, 1969, is hereby revoked.

## P.U. (A) 519.

## MALAYSIA ACT

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Malaysia Act, 26/63.  
the Yang di-Pertuan Agong hereby makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the **Modification of Laws (Census) (Modification and Extension to East Malaysia) Order, 1969.** Citation and commencement.
2. The Census Act, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), is hereby modified in the manner set out in the Schedule to this Order. Modification and extension of Act 6/60.
3. The Act as modified by Article 2 is hereby extended to Sabah and Sarawak. Extension of the Act to Sabah and Sarawak.
4. The Census Ordinances of Sabah and Sarawak are hereby repealed. Repeal of Sabah Cap. 22, Sarawak Cap. 5.

5 (1) ... ..	After "Assistant Commissioner" insert ", District Superintendent".
6 (1) ... ..	Re-number paragraphs (b), (c), (d) and (e) as (c), (d), (e) and (f) respectively and insert the following as paragraph (b): "(b) the functions of any committee appointed under section 4 (1);".
9 (2), (4), 10, 12, 14	After "Assistant Commissioner" insert "or District Superintendent".
10 (1) (a) ...	After "work-house" insert ", place of detention".
13 ... ..	For "or by an Assistant Commissioner" substitute ", an Assistant Commissioner or by a District Superintendent".
16 (1) (a) ...	For "or an Assistant Commissioner" substitute ", an Assistant Commissioner or a District Superintendent".
16 (2) ... ..	For "Any census officer" substitute "Any member of committee appointed under section 4 (1), any census officer".
