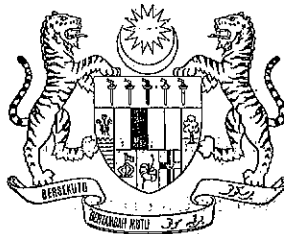

UNIVERSITY OF MALAYA ACT, 1961

(F.M. No. 44 of 1961)

STATUTE XXXIII

COMPUTER CENTRE

1. The University of Malaya Computer Centre is hereby established as an Institution of the University within the provision of section 18 of the Constitution of the University of Malaya.
2. In this Statute:
 - (a) "University" means University of Malaya.
 - (b) "Council" means the Council of the University of Malaya.
 - (c) "Senate" means the Senate of the University of Malaya.
 - (d) "Faculty" means a Faculty as defined in clause F of Statute V.
 - (e) "Board" means the Board of the Computer Centre.
 - (f) "Centre" means the Computer Centre of the University of Malaya.
 - (g) "Registered user" means a person registered with the Board as an authorised user of the computer.
3. The objects of the Centre shall be:
 - (a) to provide facilities for teaching and research in computer science and technology;
 - (b) to organise courses in computer science and technology;
 - (c) to provide computation services and facilities;
 - (d) to act as a centre of discussion and activity for persons concerned with computers and their applications;
 - (e) to perform such other functions as may be approved from time to time by the Senate.
4. The Head of the Centre shall be designated as Director. He shall be appointed by a Selection Board comprising the Vice-Chancellor, two members of Council and two members of Senate. The Director shall be a member of the Senate ex-officio.
