SPECIAL PENSIONS (RAJA PERMAISURI AGONG) ACT 1979

An Act to make special provisions for the grant of pensions, allowances and other privileges to a widowed Raja Permaisuri Agong on the demise of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong while holding office.

[1st April 1979.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Pensions (Raja Permaisuri Agong) Act 1979 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st April 1979.

Short title and commencement.

2. Where a Yang di-Pertuan Agong dies while holding office, there shall be granted to his widow the Raja Permaisuri Agong a pension of three thousand ringgit per month and allowances and privileges as specified in the Schedule.

Grant of pensions, allowance and other privileges

3. (1) Section 12 of the Pensions Ordinance 1951 shall apply to the pensions and allowances granted under this Act.

Application of section 12 of Pensions Ordinance 1951 and non-application of Income Tax Act 1967. 1/51. Act 53.

(2) The Income Tax Act 1967 shall not apply to the pensions and allowances granted under this Act.

4. The pensions and allowances granted under this Act shall be charged on the Consolidated Fund.

5. The Special Pension (Her Highness Tunku Puan Besar Kurshiah) Act 1960 and the Special Pension (Tengku Ampuan Jema'ah binti Raja Ahmad) Act 1961 are repealed.

SCHEDULE

- (a) Maintenance allowance at rates to be determined by the Government from time to time.
- (b) Car (free of road tax and registration fees) or a lump sum car allowance of \$50,000 in lieu.
- (c) Government quarters to be maintained by the Government or a lump sum house allowance of \$100,000 in lieu.
