An Act to apply a sum from the Consolidated Fund for additional expenditure for the service of the year 2010 and to appropriate that sum for certain purposes for that year.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Supply (2010) Act 2011.

Additional expenditure for the year 2010

2. The issue is hereby authorised of a sum not exceeding thirteen billion one hundred and seventy million nine hundred and ninety-seven thousand and six hundred ringgit (RM13,170,997,600) from the Consolidated Fund for additional expenditure on the services and purposes specified in the Schedule for the year 2010 not provided for or not fully provided for by the Supply Act 2010 [*Act A1361*].
