KAEDAH-KAEDAH MAHKAMAH (PINDAAN) 2025

PADA menjalankan kuasa yang diberikan oleh seksyen 17 Akta Mahkamah Kehakiman 1964 [*Akta 91*] dan seksyen 4 Akta Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah Rendah 1955 [*Akta 55*], dan dengan persetujuan Hakim Besar Mahkamah Tinggi di Malaya dan Hakim Besar Mahkamah Tinggi di Sabah dan Sarawak, Jawatankuasa Kaedah-Kaedah dan Jawatankuasa Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah Rendah membuat kaedah-kaedah yang berikut:

Nama

1. Kaedah-kaedah ini bolehlah dinamakan **Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah (Pindaan) 2025**.

Pindaan am

2. Kaedah-Kaedah Mahkamah 2012 [*P.U. (A) 205/2012*], yang disebut “Kaedah-Kaedah ibu” dalam Kaedah-Kaedah ini, dipinda—

- (a) dengan menggantikan perkataan “Pengawal” di mana-mana jua terdapat, kecuali dalam Aturan 1, dengan perkataan “Bank”; dan
- (b) dengan menggantikan perkataan “wilayah-wilayah terjadual” di mana-mana jua terdapat, kecuali dalam Aturan 1, dengan perkataan “Malaysia”.

Pindaan Aturan 1

3. Aturan 1, kaedah 4(1) Kaedah-Kaedah ibu dipinda—

- (a) dengan memotong takrif “Pengawal”;
- (b) dengan memasukkan selepas takrif “bailif” takrif yang berikut:

‘ “Bank” mempunyai erti yang diberikan kepadanya dalam Akta Perkhidmatan Kewangan 2013 [*Akta 758*];

- (c) dalam takrif “tindakan pemberi pinjam wang”, dengan menggantikan koma bernoktah di hujung perenggan itu dengan noktah; dan
- (d) dengan memotong takrif “wilayah-wilayah terjadual”.

Pindaan Aturan 6

4. Aturan 6, kaedah 7 Kaedah-Kaedah ibu dipinda—

- (a) dalam perenggan (2), dengan memotong perkataan “dan dalam tindakan admiralti lima kali”; dan
- (b) dengan memasukkan selepas perenggan (5) perenggan yang berikut:

“(6) Perenggan (1) dan (2) tidak terpakai bagi apa-apa tuntutan pemula yang berhubungan dengan kausa dan perkara Admiralti.”.

hal perkara dan nilai tuntutan, adil dan sesuai untuk didengar dan dilupuskan di Mahkamah Sesyen.”.

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Courts of Judicature Act 1964 [Act 91] and section 4 of the Subordinate Courts Rules Act 1955 [Act 55], and with the consent of the Chief Judge of the High Court in Malaya and the Chief Judge of the High Court in Sabah and Sarawak, the Rules Committee and the Subordinate Courts Rules Committee make the following rules:

Citation

1. These rules may be cited as the **Rules of Court (Amendment) 2025**.

General amendment

2. The Rules of Court 2012 [*P.U. (A) 205/2012*], which are referred to as the "principal Rules" in these Rules, are amended—

(a) by substituting for the word "Controller" wherever appearing, except in Order 1, the word "Bank"; and

(b) by substituting for the words "scheduled territories" wherever appearing, except in Order 1, the word "Malaysia".

Amendment of Order 1

3. Order 1, rule 4(1) of the principal Rules is amended—

(a) by deleting the definition of "Controller";
