Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Lotteries (Application for Permit) Regulations 1953**.

Application for permit

2. (1) An application for a permit to promote a lottery under the Act shall be made in writing, in duplicate and in the form specified in the Schedule.

(2) The application under subregulation (1) shall contain all the particulars prescribed in the form.

FORM OF APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO PROMOTE A LOTTERY

In pursuance of the Lotteries Act 1952 [Act 288], an application is made in duplicate for the issue to (full name)..... of (postal address)..... of a permit authorizing..... to promote a lottery/a series/a number of lotteries.*

This application shall contain the following particulars:

- 1. Full name, address and occupation of the promoter of the lottery/lotteries.* 1.
- 2. Where the applicant is a limited company, firm or society, the names and addresses of the directors, partners, office-bearers and secretary, as the case may be. 2.
- 3. The object for which the lottery/lotteries is/are* to be promoted. 3.
- 4. (Where applicable) The proposed number of tickets or chances to be offered for sale in the lottery/each lottery* and the prices and denominations of such tickets or chances. 4.
- 5. The conditions subject to which the tickets or chances will be offered for sale. 5.

| 12. | The proposed manner in which the names of the winners of prizes in the lottery/each lottery* shall be notified. | 12. |
| 13. | The proposed manner in which the promoter to render accounts of tickets sold or other means by which the lottery/each lottery* is to be promoted. | 13. |

N.B.—In the case of lotteries are to be promoted outside the Federation, the particulars given should include the details of the local application such as the names, addresses and occupations of the responsible local officials, and the numbers of tickets or chances to be offered for sale in the Federation.

NOTE.—This application should be addressed to—The Minister of Finance, if the total amount of the prices of the tickets or chances to be sold exceeds RM5,000; if such total amount does not exceed such sum the application should be addressed to the Menteri Besar of the State or the Yang di-Pertua Negeri of the State of Malacca or Penang in which the lottery is to be promoted or conducted.
