In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Acting Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and period in force

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Vehicle Parking Certificate for Trailers — Exemption) Order 2026.

(2) This Order is in force for the period between 6 February 2026 and 5 February 2028 (both dates inclusive).

Definition

2. In this Order, “exempt trailer” means a trailer, container trailer, low loader or flat-bed trailer, the maximum laden weight of which exceeds 5,000 kilograms.

Exemptions

3.—(1) Section 10B(1) of the Act does not apply to a person applying for the registration of an exempt trailer.

(2) Section 19(3)(f) of the Act does not apply to an exempt trailer.

(3) Rule 28(1) of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) Rules (R 5) does not apply to a person where the heavy vehicle to be transferred to the person or registered in the person's name is an exempt trailer.

(4) Rule 3(1) of the Road Traffic (Parking of Heavy Vehicles) Rules 2006 (G.N. No. S 61/2006) does not apply to a person who parks an exempt trailer.
