In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Government Vehicles — Exemption) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 April 2019.

**Definitions**

2. In this Order —

“civil defence operations vehicle” means a vehicle owned by the Government for the use of the Singapore Civil Defence Force for the purposes of civil defence;

“police operations vehicle” means a vehicle owned by the Government for the use of the Singapore Police Force for the purposes of maintaining law and order;

“specified tax” means any tax payable under Part 1 of the Act except —

- (a) a tax on the first registration of a vehicle under section 11(1)(a) of the Act; or
- (b) a vehicular emissions tax under section 11AA of the Act.

### **Operations vehicle exemption**

**3.**—(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), no specified tax, and no levy or fee under Part 1 of the Act, is chargeable in respect of any civil defence operations vehicle or police operations vehicle.

(2) Sub-paragraph (1) does not exempt from a fee payable under any rule made under section 34 of the Act.

### **Revocation**

**4.** The Road Traffic (Exemptions) (Consolidation) (No. 2) Order (O 4) is revoked.
