**Citation**

1. These Regulations are the House to House and Street Collections (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2005.

**Compoundable offences**

2.—(1) The following offences may be compounded by the Commissioner of Police in accordance with section 243 of the Criminal Procedure Code 2010<sup>2</sup>:

- (a) an offence under section 7 of the Act;

- (b) an offence under section 5(3) of the Act in relation to a contravention of regulation 4, 5, 6, 7, 12 or 14 of the House to House and Street Collections Regulations 1976.
- (2) The Commissioner of Police may compound any offence specified in paragraph (1) by collecting from the person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence —

  - (a) a sum of money not exceeding \$50 in respect of an offence mentioned in paragraph (1)(a); or
  - (b) a sum of money not exceeding \$500 in respect of an offence mentioned in paragraph (1)(b).
