ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

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In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6(2)(a) and (3)(a) of the Strategic Goods (Control) Act, the Minister for Trade and Industry makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Strategic Goods (Control) (Brokering) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 October 2019.

Strategic goods to which section 6(1) of Act applies

2. Section 6(1) of the Act applies to all strategic goods specified in the following Category Codes in Division 2 of Part 1 of the Schedule to the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2025 (G.N. No. S 660/2025):

- (a) ML1 to ML4;
- (b) ML8.

Strategic goods technology to which section 6(1) of Act applies

Section 6(1) of the Act applies to all strategic goods technology specified in Category Codes ML21 and ML22 in Division 2 of Part 1 of the Schedule to the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2025 that is necessary for the development, production or use of any strategic goods mentioned in paragraph 2.
