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In exercise of the powers conferred by section 97 of the Co-operative Societies Act, the Minister for Culture, Community and Youth makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Co-operative Societies (NTUC Enterprise Co-operative Limited — Exemption under Section 97) Order 2021 and comes into operation on 19 August 2021.

Exemption from section 39(2) of Act

2.—(1) NTUC Enterprise Co-operative Limited (called in this paragraph NEC), a secondary society, is exempt from the requirement in section 39(2) of the Act that membership in a secondary society is to be restricted to registered co-operative societies, trade unions and platform work associations, to the extent provided in sub-paragraph (2).

(2) NEC may admit NTUC Foundation Limited as a member of NEC, despite that NTUC Foundation Limited is not a registered co-operative society, trade union or platform work association.
