**MISUSE OF DRUGS
(APPROVED INSTITUTIONS, MEDICAL OBSERVATION AND
TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 58 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1973, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Misuse of Drugs (Approved Institutions, Medical Observation and Treatment and Rehabilitation) (Amendment) Regulations 2026 and come into operation on 1 May 2026.

Amendment of regulation 12

2. In the Misuse of Drugs (Approved Institutions, Medical Observation and Treatment and Rehabilitation) Regulations (Rg 3), in regulation 12 —

(a) in paragraph (2), replace sub-paragraph (e) with —

“(e) not consume any controlled drug, psychoactive substance or specified psychoactive substance;

(ea) not have in his possession —

(i) any controlled drug or psychoactive substance; or

(ii) any Part 3A product that contains a specified psychoactive substance;”;

(b) in paragraph (6), in the definition of “officer”, replace the full-stop at the end with a semi-colon; and

(c) in paragraph (6), after the definition of “officer”, insert —

““Part 3A product” has the meaning given by section 19A of the Tobacco and Vaporisers Control Act 1993;

“specified psychoactive substance” has the meaning given by section 2(1) of the Tobacco and Vaporisers Control Act 1993.”.
