CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE (CORRECTIVE TRAINING AND PREVENTIVE DETENTION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1) of the Prisons Act 1933 read with section 48(1)(a) of the Criminal Procedure (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 2024, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Criminal Procedure Code (Corrective Training and Preventive Detention) (Amendment) Regulations 2026 and come into operation on 17 August 2026.

Amendment of regulation 1

2. In the Criminal Procedure Code (Corrective Training and Preventive Detention) Regulations 2010 (G.N. No. S 803/2010) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations), in regulation 1, replace “Criminal Procedure Code” with “Prisons”.

Amendment of regulation 7

3. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 7(1)(a), before “corporal punishment”, insert “except for the aggravated prison offence mentioned in regulation 9(f),”.

Amendment of regulation 10

4. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 10(2)(b), before “corporal punishment”, insert “except for the aggravated prison offence mentioned in regulation 9(f),”.

Amendment of regulation 23

5. In the principal Regulations, in regulation 23(1)(b) and (c), before “corporal punishment”, insert “except for the aggravated prison offence mentioned in regulation 9(f),”.

Miscellaneous amendments

6. In the principal Regulations —

- (a) in regulation 2, delete the definitions of “Commissioner”, “prison” and “Superintendent”;
- (b) in regulation 2, in the definition of “Visiting Justices”, replace “Prisons Act” with “Act”; and
- (c) in regulation 16(2), replace “Prisons Act (Cap. 247)” with “Act”.
