SOCIAL RESIDENTIAL HOMES ACT 2025 (AMENDMENT OF SECOND SCHEDULE) ORDER 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 60 of the Social Residential Homes Act 2025, the Minister for Social and Family Development makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Social Residential Homes Act 2025 (Amendment of Second Schedule) Order 2026 and comes into operation on 1 July 2026 at 12.01 a.m.

Replacement of Second Schedule

2. In the Social Residential Homes Act 2025, replace the Second Schedule with —
