POLICE FORCE ACT 2004

POLICE FORCE (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 116 of the Police Force Act 2004, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order is the Police Force (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2026 and, except for paragraph 4, comes into operation on 2 June 2026.

(2) Paragraph 4 is deemed to have come into operation on 31 December 2021.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. In the Police Force (Exemption) Order 2017 (G.N. No. S 755/2017) (called in this Order the principal Order), in paragraph 2, in the definition of “security transportation”, replace “Private Security Industry (Private Investigation and Security Agencies) Regulations 2009” with “Private Security Industry (Regulated Agencies, Private Investigators and Security Officers) Regulations 2009”.

Amendment of paragraph 3

3. In the principal Order, in paragraph 3, replace “Section 86(9)(a)” with “Section 86A(1)(a) and (b)(i)”.

Miscellaneous amendments**4. In the principal Order —**

- (a) in paragraph 2, in the definition of “specified weapon”, replace “(Cap. 184)” with “1906”;
- (b) in paragraph 2, in the definition of “valid security agency’s licence”, replace “(Cap. 250A)” with “2007”;
- (c) in paragraph 3(b), replace “(Cap. 250A)” with “2007”;
- (d) in paragraph 3(b), replace “(Cap. 184)” with “1906”; and
- (e) in paragraph 3(c), after “Act”, insert “1906”.
