ROAD TRAFFIC (ELECTRONIC ROAD PRICING SYSTEM) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) RULES 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 34D and 140(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) (Amendment No. 3) Rules 2026 and come into operation on 7 September 2026.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. In the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015), in the First Schedule, after Part 14, insert —

ORCHARD AREA 1

SPECIFIED ROADS AND SPECIFIED ENTRY POINTS
