**CYBERSECURITY  
(CYBERSECURITY SERVICE PROVIDERS)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of the Cybersecurity Act 2018, the Minister for Digital Development and Information, Josephine Teo, who is charged with the responsibility for cybersecurity, makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations are the Cybersecurity (Cybersecurity Service Providers) (Amendment) Regulations 2026 and come into operation on 13 July 2026.

**Amendment of regulation 2**

**2.** In the Cybersecurity (Cybersecurity Service Providers) Regulations 2022 (G.N. No. S 304/2022), in regulation 2 —

(a) replace paragraph (2) with —

“(2) For the purposes of section 26(1)(a) of the Act, the prescribed form is the form set out on the electronic application service mentioned in paragraph (1).”; and

(b) in paragraph (3), replace “2 months” with “one day”.

**Amendment of regulation 5**

**3.** In the Cybersecurity (Cybersecurity Service Providers) Regulations 2022, in regulation 5(a), replace “<https://www.mci.gov.sg>” with “<https://www.mddi.gov.sg>”.
