**GAMBLING CONTROL
(FUNDRAISERS — CLASS LICENCE)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 60 of the Gambling Control Act 2022, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Gambling Control (Fundraisers — Class Licence) (Amendment) Order 2026 and comes into operation on 27 August 2026.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. In the Gambling Control (Fundraisers — Class Licence) Order 2022 (G.N. No. S 661/2022), in paragraph 2(1) —

- (a) in the definition of “approved purpose”, in paragraph (c), delete “or” at the end;
- (b) in the definition of “approved purpose”, replace paragraph (d) with —
 - “(d) any sector member of the National Council of Social Service; or
 - (e) in relation to a gambling service provided between 27 August 2026 and 26 August 2028 (both dates inclusive) by conducting a fundraiser lottery — any organisation that —
 - (i) provides an indirect social service; or

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- (ii) provides services or mobilises resources for the benefit of the social service sector;”;
 - (c) in the definition of “benefitting organisation”, replace paragraph (d) with —
 - “(d) any sector member of the National Council of Social Service;
 - (e) in relation to a fundraiser lottery conducted between 27 August 2026 and 26 August 2028 (both dates inclusive) — any organisation that —
 - (i) provides an indirect social service; or
 - (ii) provides services or mobilises resources for the benefit of the social service sector;”;
 - (d) in the definition of “eligible person”, replace paragraph (d) with —
 - “(d) any sector member of the National Council of Social Service;
 - (da) in relation to a fundraiser lottery conducted between 27 August 2026 and 26 August 2028 (both dates inclusive) — any organisation that —
 - (i) provides an indirect social service; or
 - (ii) provides services or mobilises resources for the benefit of the social service sector;”;
 - (e) after the definition of “net proceeds”, insert —
 - ““organisation that provides an indirect social service” means any organisation that —
 - (a) provides an indirect social service;

(b) immediately before 1 August 2026, held an appointment as an associate Council member mentioned in section 15(1)(b) of the National Council of Social Service Act 1992 as in force immediately before 1 August 2026;

(c) is registered under the Business Names Registration Act 2014 or the Societies Act 1966, incorporated under the Companies Act 1967, or established by or under any written law; and

(d) has been carrying on business for a continuous period of at least 2 years;

“organisation that provides services or mobilises resources for the benefit of the social service sector” means any organisation that —

(a) has the primary function of providing services or mobilising resources (financial or in kind, including the services of volunteers) for the benefit of the social service sector;

(b) immediately before 1 August 2026, held an appointment as an associate Council member mentioned in section 15(1)(b) of the National Council of Social Service Act 1992 as in force immediately before 1 August 2026;

(c) is registered under the Business Names Registration Act 2014 or the Societies Act 1966, incorporated under the Companies Act 1967, or established by or under any written law; and

(d) has been carrying on business for a continuous period of at least 2 years;” and

(f) after the definition of “scrutineer”, insert —

““sector member of the National Council of Social Service” means a sector member as defined in section 2 of the National Council of Social Service Act 1992;”.

Miscellaneous amendments

3. In the Gambling Control (Fundraisers — Class Licence) Order 2022, in the following provisions, replace “or (d)” wherever it appears with “, (d) or (da)”:

Paragraph 2(1), definition of “eligible person”, paragraph (e)

Paragraph 2(1), definition of “sponsoring eligible person”

Paragraph 2(1), definition of “sponsorship-like arrangement”, paragraphs (a) and (b)

Paragraph 6(a)

Paragraph 8(1)(a)(x).
